Replication workshop design

There will be three rounds of the replication workshop each consisting of several round tables. The most innovative Lighthouse cities smart solutions (or even fellow cities) will be elaborated during round tables. Each round table will consist of 30 minutes of presentation by the city and 30 minutes of discussion. One round table will be ready for up to ten participants.

While some round tables will focus more on technical aspects of selected smart solution, others will be devoted more to the implementation processes – governance aspects, used business models, public procurement, citizen engagement and data usage.

Each round table will be facilitated. Facilitators of the workshop will collect information on the most important findings.

Participation in the workshop will be available for all visitors of the fair requiring prior registration. During the registration the preference will be given to the city representatives (decision makers, politicians etc.). Attendees will be able to choose from round tables and will receive basic information about selected smart solutions in advance of the event.
