### Practical information

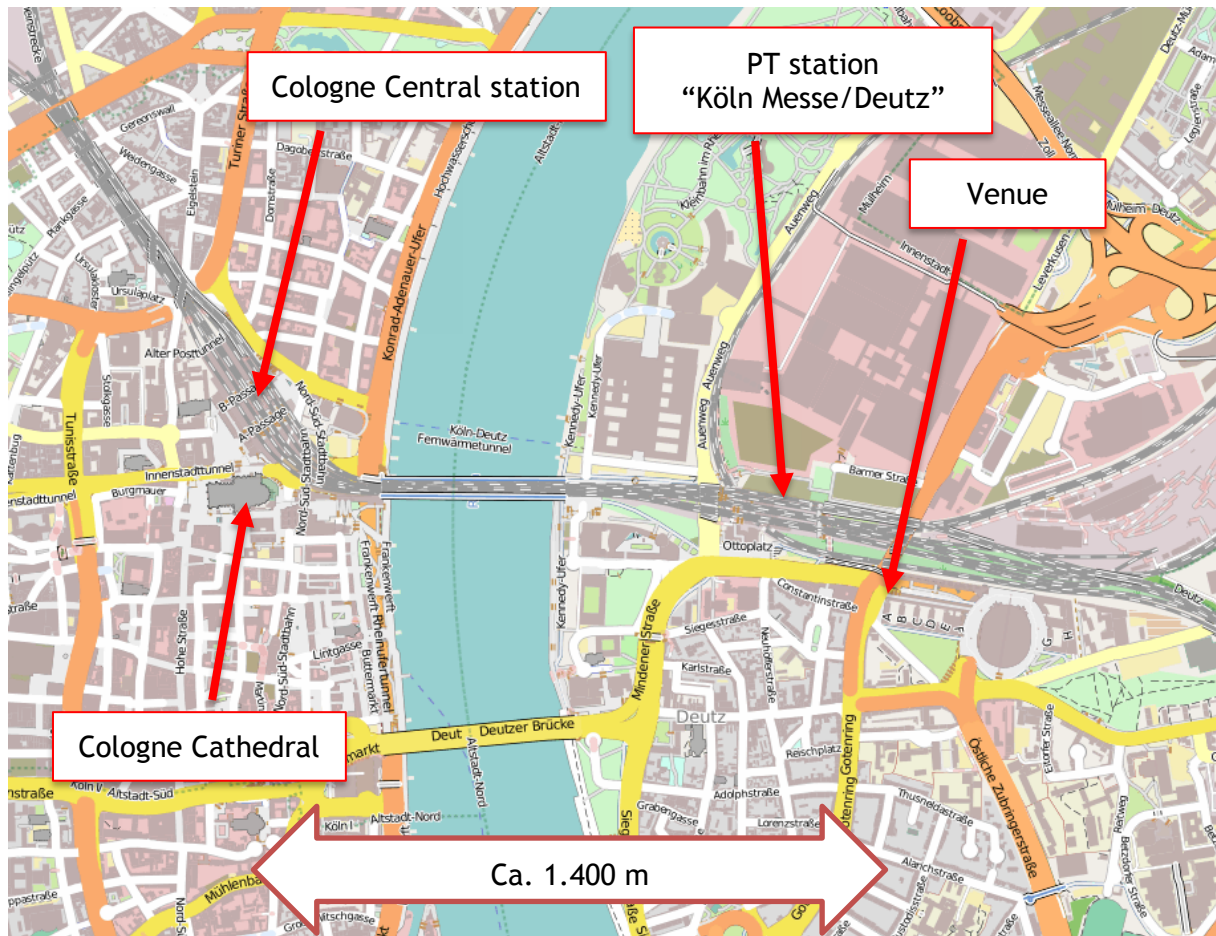
- Transport between “Cologne Bonn airport” (CGN) and venue: use “S19” (platform 2, direction Düren or Sindorf) or “RE8” (platform 1, direction Mönchengladbach); remember to buy a valid ticket, pricelevel “1b” for 3,00 EUR.

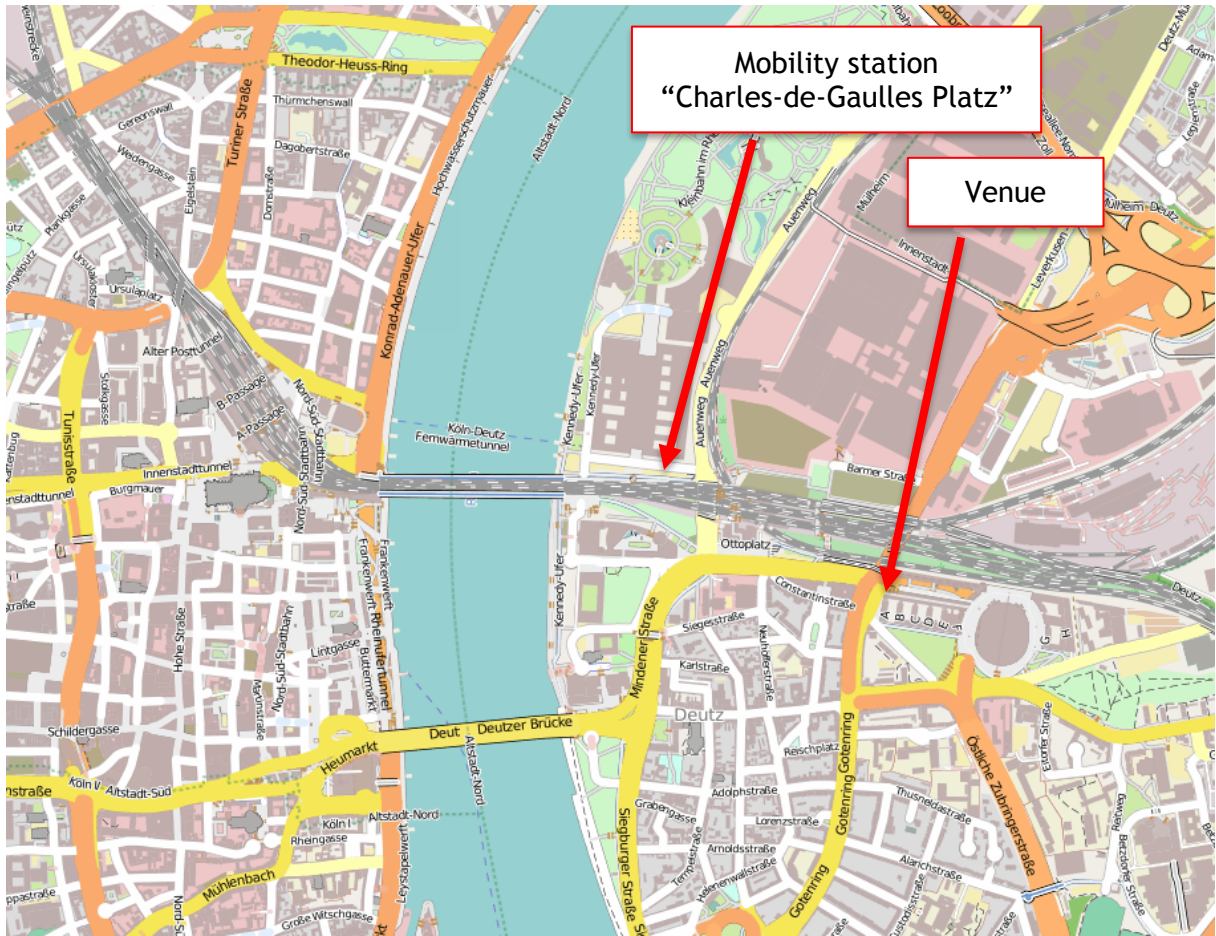

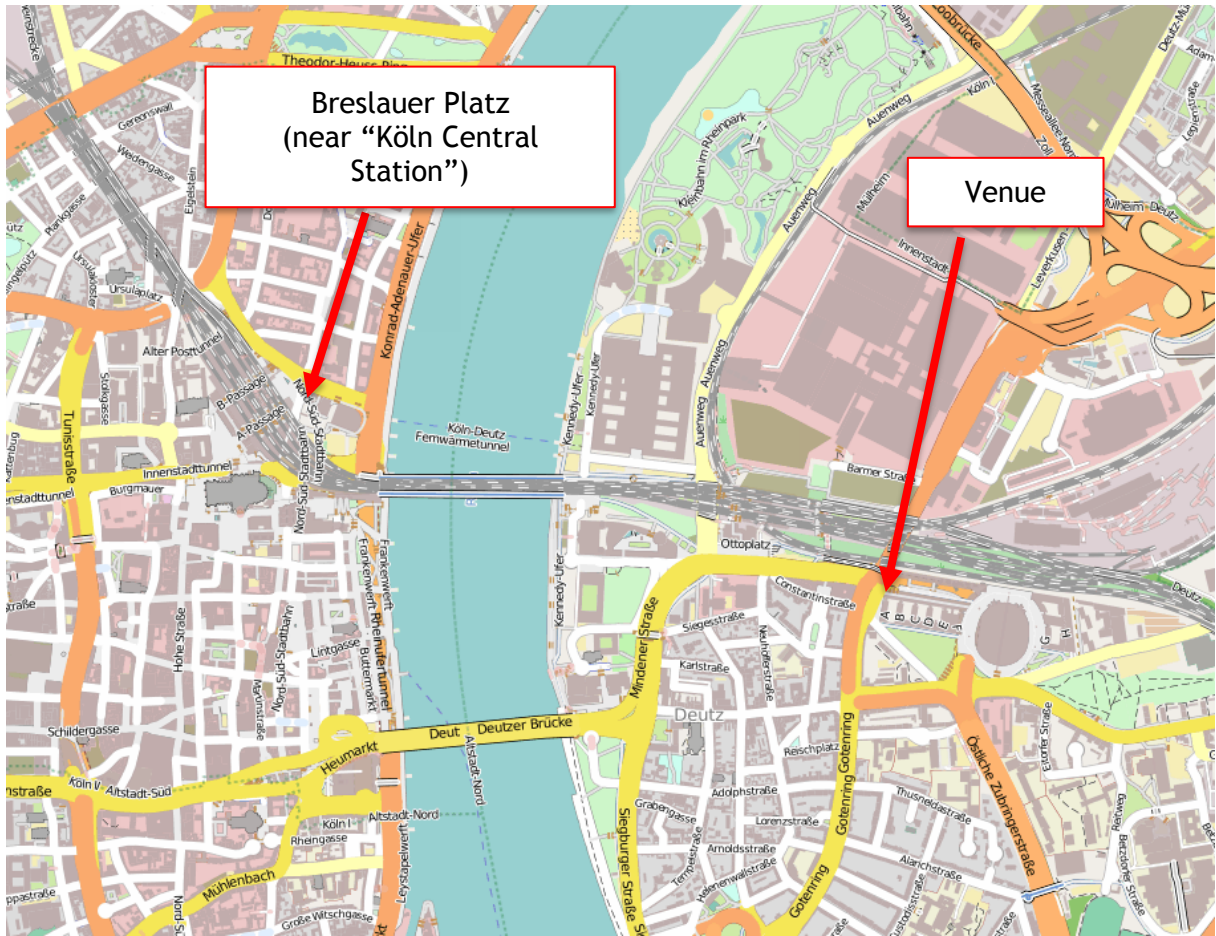

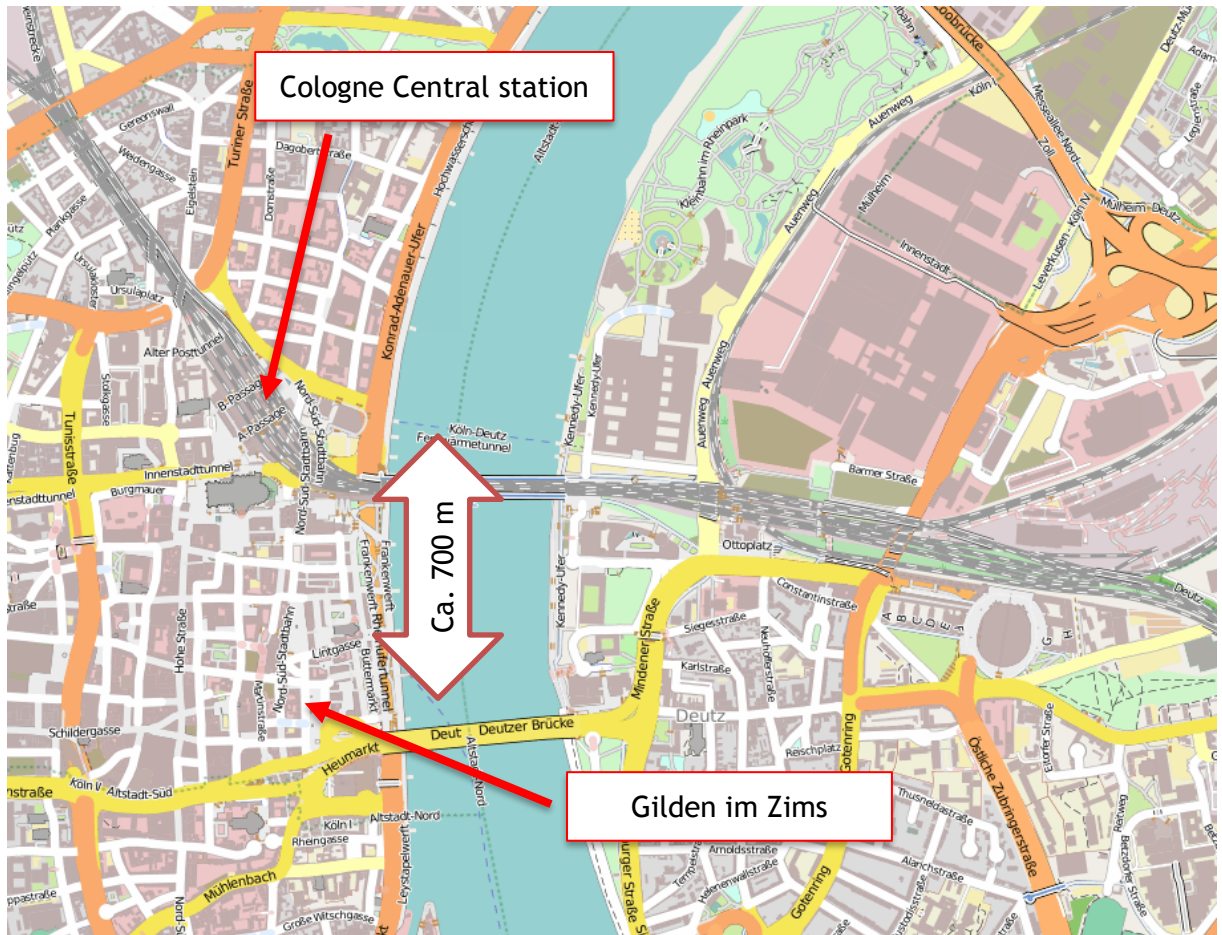


- Site visit 2 - zero emission bus fleets
