Background: It is reported that within each city, there is a group of homeless people who do not respond to the standard interventions. This is often because they have multiple and complex needs, for example a combination of drug addiction and mental illness, which the current system does not fully address. They are at risk of becoming or have become chronically homeless, sleep rough or are entrenched within the homelessness system. This study visit aims to exchange experiences of working with this target group, explore good practices and possible approaches, to support cities in addressing this issue.
