



Letter of intent

With the following intentions we want to raise the issue about EU-migrants on both a national level and a European Commission level. We request that:

- The major role of the cities is emphasized when discussing human mobility and migration in a) State policies, and on b) European Commission level.
- The challenges of mobility, integration and service provision are happening on a local level, in cities, and therefore the experiences of the cities have to be taken into account on the highest political agenda in national and EU-policies.
- More coordinated action from a national level and from the European Union is taken. The issue of impoverished EU citizens who are begging or settling in tent camps in our cities is too large to be handled by individual municipalities.
- Joint coordination around how we handle the time when residence law applies and when it expired.
- Initiatives should be taken by the European Parliament and the Commission on development projects in Member States where we see that these group's origins from. Projects that are financed by the EU funds to boost up local entrepreneurship and education levels.
- The treaties we jointly supported compliance when it comes to social rights and protection systems.
