# OUR RESPONSE

- DEFINITION of Municipal Waste should be:  
**‘Municipal solid waste’ means household waste and all waste from commercial and industrial activities which is similar to household waste.**
- A wide definition ensures comparable statistics at EU level
- This is not a public-private debate

# OUR RESPONSE

- CALCULATION METHOD
- There should be only **ONE** calculation method for Recycling

**Based on after sorting & output method**

- Encourage Quality Recycling
- No more hassle with 4 alternatives

# OUR RESPONSE

- TARGETS
- **We welcome new ambitious targets, but they**
  - **Have to be developed based on facts and new calculation method**
  - **Too early to set fixed targets**

# OUR RESPONSE

- LANDFILL BAN
- **We welcome landfill ban, but “recyclables” is too vague**
- Use existing definitions from Member States
- Timetable should adjust to level of development

- EXTENDED PRODUCER RESPONSIBILITY RULES
- **We welcome EU-wide rules**
- EPR does not always apply
