Malmo aims to reduce per capita energy use by 20% by 2020. Climate Living in Cities Concept (CLICC) is an important part of this plan: it targets household carbon emissions by refurbishing three post-war housing compounds - 1200 households - and carrying out awareness-raising activities. Through these actions, the project has its own ambitious goal of reducing carbon emissions within these housing compounds by 50% by 2014.
