On November 29th,

a European Symposium will be held at the Ile-de-France Regional Council. This conference will provide an update on the progress of the action plans required by the European Directive 2002/49/EC. It will present good practices implemented by major European cities to fight against noise and allow experience-sharing. Open to all, this day of debate will allow local and regional authorities to enhance their knowledge in noise management and to adopt the required tools to strengthen their noise action plan.

On November 30th,

the City of Paris will explain its noise actions in terms of traffic management and street design, with a particular focus on the multiple strategies against noise implemented on the Paris Ring Road. An on-site visit (Porte de Vincennes) will offer a better understanding of the issue and of the actions already implemented or planned.

This morning session, organized by the City of Paris, is open to all people attending the Conference of November 29th who would like to come.

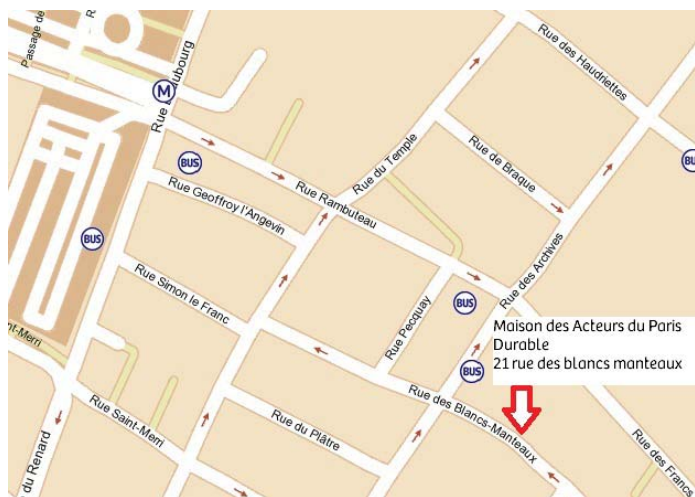
