

STOCKHOLM ROYAL SEAPORT

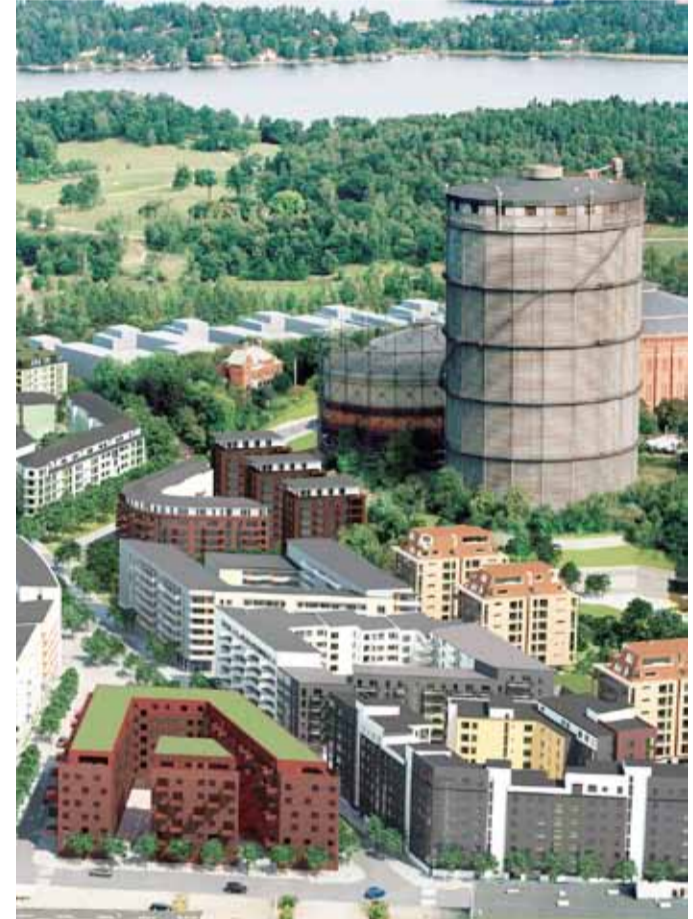
