Background and Introduction to the Consortium



- September 2016 : launch of a new initiative by Jean-Claude Juncker

The European Solidarity Corps project by Pôle Emploi:

- Funded by EaSI Programme, coordinated by DG EMPL
- 2,5 years (02/05/2017 – 31/12/2019)
- 12 partners: 9 public employment agencies, 3 private organisations
- Partner countries: BE, BG, DE, ES, FR, IT, LU, PT





What is ESC4Y?



- Target: 4000 paid short term work placements (job, traineeship, apprenticeship)
- Duration 2 – 12 months
- Young Europeans 18-30 years old
- Sectors: any sector is eligible
 - In solidarity sectors, any work placement is eligible (social & health, aid to refugees, environment)
 - In other sectors, work placements need to have a solidarity dimension (eg CSR activities)



Solidarity related sectors



Health care, including long-term care, health promotion/disease prevention activities	Social integration/Social work, including the reception and integration of asylum seekers and migrants, child care, elderly care, assistance to disabled people	Environmental protection
Education, literacy training	Emergency and disaster management (Non immediate response)	Food aid
Creativity and culture	Physical education and sport	Citizenship and democratic participation



Who is eligible?



Your organisation needs to:

- Be **legally established** (have a legal identity) in the European Union
- Offer a **paid fixed term** job, traineeship or apprenticeship with a solidarity dimension
- Be compliant with **labour and fiscal laws** applicable in the country where you are established and where the work placement takes place





What's in it for cities/employers?



- Easy way to post your vacancies
- Pre-selected *candidates* send to you by professional employment advisers → admin burden reduced
- Financial assistance for the integration programme (2,000 € max)
- Support by dedicated employment counsellors all along the process
- Young talented and motivated people rapidly available
- CSR aspect enhanced
- Opening/broadening the multicultural dimension

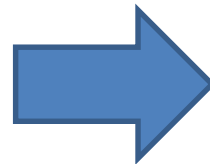
